Friday Halaqa After Isha (Coordinated by Br Wajed Syed)

Every Friday after Isha, there is always a halaqa session open to all at ISCJ. In the summer time, it is after Magrib time. Br Wajed Syed coordinates a different speaker and topic every Friday.

Saturday After Zuhr Knowledge Class (Led by Imam Moustafa Zayed)

Every Saturday at 1:30 pm an Islamic knowledge class is taught by Imam Moustafa Zayed, author of *The Lies About Muhammad*. This on-going class aims at teaching Islamic knowledge and fiqh to all levels of Muslims. Non-Muslims are always welcomed. The class has an open format so questions are always welcomed and each one addressed. The class is open to both brothers and sisters.

Sunday After Fajr Tafseer (Led by Dr Esseghir)

Every Sunday after Fajr, there is a tafseer class led by Dr Mohammad Esseghir.

Please join us in this weekly Tafseer Program, (now in its 5th year); a reading session from Tafseer Ibn Katheer, an opportunity to dive into a wealth of Qur'anic wisdom from the best and most authentic commentators of the Qur'an. Ibn Katheer's methodology stands out as he explains a Quranic verse by first using other related verses. Afterwards, he uses Hadith and Circumstances of Revelation to strengthen the explanation. Finally, he brings the understanding of the Companions and Tabe'ens for further explanation. Scholars of Tafseer acknowledge this was one of the greatest contributions of Imam Ibn Katheer and some refer to his Tafseer as "nothing like it was ever written".
